The home, down to the sprinkler system, is slated for completion at the end of this year. “This is a charitable event we are especially looking forward to,” says Rusty Morgan, President of Structura, Inc., “as it’s one where we will be able to witness firsthand the benefit to the family in need. We are hoping to stay involved annually, through the AGC.” Ryan Therrell of The Beck Group says that Habitat plans to build 20 such homes in Travis County in the coming year.

Also in the coming months, Structura will be a corporate sponsor of the Central Texas Chapter Leukemia & Lymphoma Society’s Team in Training event (<http://www.teamintraining.org>) in cooperation with Nike Running, where the team will contribute its earnings to the care of several cancer patients from this area, including five year old Emily, who was diagnosed with Acute Lymphocytic Leukemia. “Team In Training is a group that increases awareness of the work of The Leukemia and Lymphoma Society and raises money towards finding cures for leukemia, lymphoma, Hodgkin’s disease, and myeloma,” explains Becky Douglas, a Structura employee who joined Team in Training in 2003. Douglas is also a member of Austin Luna Chix, a local group of women athletes ([http://www.lunabar.com/pages/teamluna\\_lunachix/lunachix/austin/](http://www.lunabar.com/pages/teamluna_lunachix/lunachix/austin/)) handpicked by Luna Bar/Clif Bar

to get women outside and active. “The object is to raise awareness for The Breast Cancer Fund and fundraise for them at our annual Luna Fest, a film festival held in November, ‘08,” says Douglas, where Structura will continue its involvement. In addition, Structura will be a sponsor for the Longhorn Ironman 70.3 (<http://ironman.com/events/ironman70.3/longhorn70.3>) half-Ironman event in Austin on October 5, 2008.
