Rusty Morgan, a third generation Austinite, A & M Construction Science graduate and Structura President, and Kevin Jones, also an A&M Graduate and Vice President of Operations for the thriving company, say they pride themselves most strongly on being able to finish jobs “fast” and making a difficult, challenging job seem “routine.”

“We attribute a great deal of our success to repeat clients and to client referrals,” says Morgan. “Having worked in the construction industry all over Texas for the last 25 years,” continues Morgan “we have become well educated about who’s who in this business. We’ve developed strong relationships along the way, and in the end, relationships with people is what good business is all about.” The company’s rapid growth speaks volumes about their reputations, personally and professionally.

The company, opened in December of 2006 by these two under-fifty entrepreneurs, now boasts some of the most prestigious clients in the city, and is quickly building its project list in Dallas, Houston, and San Antonio.

Among some of the most notable are Latinworks in downtown Austin, Dell Children’s Medical Center Trauma Services Offices, a number of Chase Bank branches, and AT&T switch facilities.

Another project Structura is particularly proud of is the RSI, Inc. facility in Kyle, Texas, which is a leading provider of hyper-rugged IT systems designed for military application. “This was a very technically challenging job,” remembers Morgan. “We had only four months to erect the building structure and finish out the 40,000 SF space, where computers are built to be used in rugged situations like combat, for example, or in stressful weather conditions. We finished on time and enjoyed every minute of it.”

These are the kinds of projects, the ones that require turn on a dime, under-the-gun attention, where Structura is known to excel.

“Constellation Energy is a 10,000 square foot project that we had to finish in four weeks. It’s a facility that is used for energy distribution back-up when Houston is in an energy emergency, like under hurricane conditions for example,” explains Jones. “We love that time crunch kind of a challenge,” he admits, “because we’ve yet to fail to meet it!”

Structura opened its doors with only 3 employees less than 18 months ago. Today, with 100 full time employees and offices in Austin, Houston and Dallas, Structura, Inc. has proven it’s not daunted by any project, large or small. As a fledgling new company in Austin’s overcrowded building market, Structura’s profits and project list continue to burgeon. More green and sustainable building projects are on their to-do list, since they have LEED certified staff, and data centers and healthcare facility building opportunities are among their favorite assignments.
